#### **How to reach Parma**

To whom comes **from Milan-Turin**: take A1 to Bologna, and exit at Parma Centre (2<sup>nd</sup> station)

To whom comes **from Genoa**: take the motorway to Piacenza, then follows to Bologna and exit at Parma Centre (2<sup>nd</sup> station)

To whom comes **from Viareggio-La Spezia**: take direction Parma and at the end of the connecting road take A1 to Bologna and exit at Parma Centre (1st station)

To whom comes **from Roma, Firenze, Bologna**: take A1 to Milan and exit at Parma Centre (1<sup>st</sup> station)

To whom comes **from Verona-Venezia**: take the motorway to Modena, then A1 to Milan and exit Parma Centre (1st station)

#### **How to reach Starhotel du Parc**
