





# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS 10 "ANNA MATTIOLI" SCHOLARSHIPS, FUNDED BY THE ANNA MATTIOLI ETS FOUNDATION, RESERVED FOR UKRAINIAN STUDENTS ENROLLED IN DEGREE COURSES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PARMA, 2022/2023 ACADEMIC YEAR

The University of Parma, the ER.GO Regional Agency for the Right to Higher Education, and the Anna Mattioli ETS Foundation (A.M.F.), thanks to a contribution provided by the A.M.F, hereby publish an open call for applications for 10 scholarships in tuition and services reserved for Ukrainian students for the 2022/2023 academic year.

## **Article 1: Purpose and Recipients**

The recipients are to be Ukrainian students enrolling in, or already enrolled in, undergraduate, graduate, and single-cycle degree programs at the University of Parma for the 2022/2023 academic year who do not have personal or family income in Italy, or refugees from Ukraine who have formal refugee status in Italy based on current national directives.

The University of Parma reserves the right to verify any information included in the application, with particular reference to:

- Residence of the family unit
- Presence of the applicant's personal or family income in Italy.

# **Article 2: Scholarship Content**

The ten "Anna Mattioli" Scholarships include:

- Monetary scholarship of € 3,500 (the sum includes the charges borne by the University);
- Free accommodation at "Residence il Parmigianino", made available by the A.M.F., for the academic year 2022/2023, for a total period of twelve months;
- Prepaid access to catering services worth € 500.00 to be used by 31 December 2023 at the ER.GO and/or affiliated catering services;
- Total exemption from 2022/2023 academic year university fees, with the exception of the €140 regional tax and the €16 virtual stamp ("bollo virtuale").

The following support services will also be provided:

- welcome, orientation, introduction and inclusion at the University and social life;
- assistance with the degree course admissions process and support throughout the course of studies with, for example, Italian language courses and material provisions for distance learning, availability of personal tutors for aiding integration, counseling activities in the case of temporary periods of difficulty.







### **Article 3: Requirements**

The students who are applying, as mentioned in Article 1, must be enrolled in the 2022/2023 academic year within the set time period, without tuition debts and administrative penalties.

### **Article 4: Scholarship Payment**

The monetary scholarship will arrive in two separate installments:

- the first installment will be paid upon completion of enrollment or enrollment renewal for the 2022/23 academic year;
- the second installment will be paid after March 31, 2023 on the condition that there has been no withdrawal from studies, transfer to another university, or other forms of suspension or academic closure.

# **Article 5: Methods and Deadlines for Application Submission**

The application period is open from June 30<sup>th</sup> to August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, only and exclusively online, at the following link <a href="https://www.idem.unipr.it/secure/bandoucraina">https://www.idem.unipr.it/secure/bandoucraina</a>.

The following must be included, as documents attached to the application:

- 1. A copy of the permit of residence ("permesso di soggiorno") or a copy of the application for a permit of asylum, political asylum, subsidiary protection, or complementary protection (e.g. special protection and special cases), residence permit for temporary protection;
- 2. A curriculum vitae;
- 3. A cover letter explaining the candidate's motivations

All documents submitted must be written in Italian or English. If a document is provided in a different language, it must be accompanied by an Italian translation on unstamped paper.

With respect to the deadline of August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, should the admissible applications presented be fewer than the number of scholarships available, the call will be reopened, the deadlines of which will be defined in accordance with ER.GO and A.M.F.

### Article 6: Selection Procedure and Evaluation Criteria

The selection procedure will be carried out by a joint University Commission, ER.GO, and A.M.F., appointed by the University Dean.

The selection criteria are defined by the Commission, ensuring an equitable gender distribution and agreeing on the preference for younger applicants. The criteria, defined in the first session of the Commission, have been made public through publication on the University website at the link <a href="https://www.unipr.it/node/32601">https://www.unipr.it/node/32601</a>.







For newly enrolled students, the selection criteria will be:

- cover letter explaining the candidate's motivations
- curriculum vitae

For students already enrolled in courses of study at the University of Parma the selection criteria will be:

academic merit in relation to the course year

Applications from newly enrolled students will receive priority from the Commission.

The outcome of the Commission's assessment will be communicated to the applicants' e-mail address.

### **Article 7: Scholarship Not Combinable**

The scholarship and the benefits outlined in this announcement cannot be combined with scholarships and other benefits provided by public and private entities within the framework and purposes of university study.

In particular, the scholarships referred to in this announcement are incompatible with the scholarships and financial contributions provided for in other ER.GO calls for applications.

## **Article 8: Treatment of personal data**

The personal data provided by the application for participation in the call will be treated in compliance with the

right to the protection of personal data and rights to the protection of privacy and personal identity (EU Regulation 2016/679 c.d. GDPR, legislative decree 30.06.2003, n.196 and subsequent amendments), exclusively for the obligations connected to the execution of this call for applications.
