PREMISE

EcosistER | **The territorial innovation ecosystem of Emilia-Romagna** (<u>https://ecosister.it/</u>) is the project funded by the PNRR that brings together key regional actors to strengthen Emilia-Romagna's global leadership in applied research and ensure effective capacity to support sustainable, resilient, and people-centered industrial development through the implementation of green transition, in line with the objectives of the Pact for Jobs and Climate.

The EcosistER project, managed by the homonymous Foundation, is funded by the PNRR and involves 23 partners, including 6 universities, 4 research institutes, 13 public-private organizations based in Emilia-Romagna, along with ART-ER.

EcosistER promotes research activities in 6 macro areas:

- Materials for sustainability and ecological transition
- Production, storage, and saving of clean energy
- Green production for a sustainable economy
- Intelligent mobility, housing, and energy solutions
- Circular economy and blue economy
- Transition based on HPC and data-based technologies

EcosistER promotes the **Technology Transfer Innovation Programme** (TTIP), which aims to promote industrial research as the main driver for sustainable economic development.

In particular, within the framework of the TTIP program, actions of "training" are foreseen, promoted and developed by the Pillar Training (CUP **E93C22001100001**), with the aim of strengthening the transversal skills of PhD students and Researchers. This activity is coordinated by the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia with the support of ART-ER and involves all the spokes and some affiliates.

This document aims to select PhD candidates and temporary researchers to participate in the Summer School "Open Innovation Management for Sustainable Transition," a residential training course lasting 5 days, which will take place from June 10th to 14th, 2024, at the Foresteria di Capaccio, in the Settegalli locality, Santa Sofia (FC).













No responsibility can be attributed to ART-ER, Ecosister partners or their structures because of any delays or changes in the timing and manner of the services provided by the initiative. The changes will be determined by the organisation in such a way as to ensure that the objectives of the programme are achieved.

1. PURPOSE OF THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

This expression of interest concerns the participation in the first edition of the EcosistER Summer School "Open Innovation Management for a Sustainable Transition", promoted by the Pillar Training, and aims to:

 select up to thirty (30) PhD candidates, researchers (meeting the requirements outlined in point 2) to give them the opportunity to participate in an experiential training program dedicated to acquiring skills in **Innovation Management on the themes of sustainable transition.** The aim is to enhance the knowledge of PhD candidates and researchers on the methodologies and strategies of Open Innovation management, useful for building professional profiles capable of exploiting the opportunities provided by the regional Innovation Ecosystem and dedicated to managing innovation processes and change towards sustainable transition.

2. RECIPIENTS AND REQUIREMENTS

Eligible for selection for the Summer School "Open Innovation Management for a Sustainable Transition" are:

- 1. All PhD candidates enrolled in universities in the Emilia-Romagna region and in the Piacenza locations of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore and the Politecnico di Milano;
- 2. All temporary researchers of type A (RTD-A) with an active contract until June 30, 2024 at least, enrolled in universities in the Emilia-Romagna region and in the Piacenza locations of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore and the Politecnico di Milano;
- 3. All temporary researchers with an active contract until June 30, 2024 at least, with the National Research Council (Emilia Romagna headquarters).













3. SUBJECT

The Summer School will take place **from June 10th to 14th 2024** at the Foresteria di Capaccio, Settegalli locality, Santa Sofia (FC), and will include:

 A dedicated program, in english language, on methodologies, strategies of Open Innovation Management applied to Sustainable Transition issues, characterized by: 1) frontal lectures; 2) group work on case studies; 3) testimonials and dialogue with companies from the regional ecosystem; 4) lectures by international experts on sustainable transition issues; 5) role-playing and simulations for the approach and resolution of real cases. The program will also include Study visits to entrepreneurial realities to acquire knowledge of the most innovative innovation paths dedicated to sustainable transition. Networking initiatives and animation of the participant community are also planned.

Free meals and accommodation will be provided for the entire duration of the course to the 30 selected participants.

<u>The course will begin on June 10, 2024, and will conclude on June 14, 2024, and will be</u> completely free for participants with no registration fees requested.

4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS

The deadline for submitting applications is set at 1:00 PM (Italian time) on May 6, 2024.

All communications regarding this expression of interest for applications following the submission of the application will be communicated through the website <u>www.art-er.it</u>, in the section Notices and Tenders - Contributions and Economic Benefits ((<u>https://www.art-er.it/bandi-e-avvisi/contributi-e-vantaggi-economici/</u>) and **to the address indicated in the Application Form.**

ART-ER reserves the right to request additions to the application before deciding on the exclusion of an application. This request will be made to the e-mail address indicated at the time of application.

If the email address provided by the candidate is incorrect, ART-ER is not responsible for any negative consequences resulting from a lack of or defective communications related to the process.

By applying, participants commit to accepting without reservation all the conditions stated in this expression of interest for applications and any related integrations and/or modifications that will be published on the ART-ER website.

5. PROCEDURE FOR FORMAL INSTRUCTION AND EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

The instruction and evaluation of applications occur in 2 phases, preceded by a formal eligibility check.

• **Phase 1 Formal eligibility check**: formal verification of the completeness of the documentation by the Responsible of the Proceedings appointed by ART-ER, tasked with verifying the completeness and compliance of the documentation according to what is stated in point 2 of this Notice.

Applications that do not meet the requirements specified in Article 2 will be excluded.













The Responsible of the Proceedings appointed by ART-ER, or personnel delegated by it, may request additional information before proceeding with the determination of the exclusion of an application.

• **Phase 2 - Ranking of eligible candidacies**: the technical analysis of the documents and the elaboration of a ranking will be carried out by the Evaluation Committee of the applications appointed by ART-ER.

The ranking will be based on the following criteria, where to each of them is assigned a relative score according to the following table. For each criterion, a minimum threshold value is also provided.

Evaluation Criteria	Maximum Value	Minimum threshold value (>=)
 A) Clarity in defining the expected results of the research project and their environmental, social and economic impact 	30	20
B) Motivation for participation to the program	30	20
C) Coherence of the research project with sustainable transition issues	20	10

In addition to these three criteria, this expression of interest also provides the following bonuses:

20 points if the research or doctoral scholarship is funded within the EcosistER program.













The maximum achievable score is 100 points. The minimum threshold for inclusion in the ranking is 60 points.

Only candidates who have achieved a score greater than or equal to (>=) the minimum threshold for each evaluation criterion (points A, B, and C) will be eligible for the ranking.

The selection process will seek to ensure, in accordance with the criteria eligibility and minimum threshold requirements, a fair gender distribution among those admitted to the program. In case of a tie in scores, priority will be given to **younger candidates**.

6. COMMUNICATION OF RESULTS

The list of admitted beneficiaries will be published on the website of the implementing body ART-ER (<u>www.art-er.it</u>). Candidates will be notified via email of the outcome of the evaluation at the **address provided in the application form.**

In case of withdrawal of the candidacy or inability to participate in the program by one or more beneficiaries, ART-ER reserves the right to move down the ranking, even after the start of the program.

7. CONTROLS, REVOCATIONS, SANCTIONS

Beneficiaries are required to provide ART-ER or other authorized entities with all information, data, and reports requested, in order to ensure the monitoring of activities related to this expression of interest for applications for the 3 years following the closing date of this expression of interest.

As the implementing body of the expression of interest, ART-ER may conduct all necessary checks and reserves the right to carry out random checks, even on a sample basis, to verify compliance with and maintenance of the conditions and requirements requested. If the specified conditions and requirements are not met, ART-ER reserves the right to exclude













beneficiaries from the program.

8. CHANGES REGARDING BENEFICIARIES

During the period between the submission of the application and the conclusion of the program, beneficiaries are required to promptly communicate to ART-ER any changes and any other facts related to the subjective requirements that may result in the loss of any of the requirements specified by the expression of interest.
