## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Exchange students meeting the language requirements established by each Department (see each Department's Infosheet) will normally be permitted to attend courses at the University of Parma. Final acceptance will be effective upon completion of the administrative requirements for exchange students and the approval of the Learning Agreement for Studies/Traineeship.

## PROCEDURES AND DEADLINES

1. In order to guarantee the correct management of exchange students' applications, the students' home institution must make sure to complete the nominations of the selected students before the following deadlines:

2. Student nominations are made [as per the procedure and documents available at this link](#).
3. The University of Parma contacts students individually after the nomination deadline to provide them with detailed instructions on the application procedures.
4. Students must submit their application, complete with the required documentation, as per the instructions available at <https://www.unipr.it/en/application-erasmus>.
5. Students will be notified of the acceptance decision via e-mail. The University of Parma issues Letters of Acceptance only for visa purposes. A declaration of exchange student status for specific purposes can be issued upon request by contacting [incoming@unipr.it](mailto:incoming@unipr.it). The issuance of both documents is subject to the completion of the application process and the signature of the Learning Agreement by all parties.
6. It is highly recommended that students arrive and settle in Parma a few days before classes begin, in order to allow time for the necessary administrative procedures. A Welcome Day is held every semester that students are warmly invited to participate in.

## DIDACTIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE ASPECTS

### 1. Organization of the Academic Year

### 2. Transcript of Records issuance and grading system of the institution

A Transcript of Records is issued by the University of Parma no later than five weeks after the student's return to his/her home university.

Italian universities adopt a 1-to-30 grading scale, with 18/30 set as "Pass" threshold. In relation to grade conversion, the University of Parma adheres to the [EGRACONS](#) system.

### 3. Visa

Exchange students must check entry requirements into Italy by filling the [Ministry of Foreign Affairs questionnaire](#).

Exchange students who need a visa for their stay in Parma must use the official [University portal](#) to start the visa procedure. Students [need to register \(create an account\)](#) in the portal and fill the pre-enrolment application selecting "I want to spend a period of mobility for study/Traineeship (e.g. Erasmus)".

### 4. Insurance

Exchange students must acquire adequate health and civil liability insurance coverage by the starting date of the mobility and for its whole duration.

In case of pending conditions, the University of Parma may provide assistance in obtaining the compulsory insurance policies.

Please note that in case of internships or practical activity in Medicine or health-related disciplines, exchange students must submit additional insurances (please refer to the Department of Medicine and Surgery Information Sheet).
