## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE “AQUATIC AND OUTDOOR SPORTS EVENT”, October 19–23, 2026, at the Centro Internacional de Innovación Deportiva en el Medio Natural “El Anillo”, Spain

### ENGLISH VERSION

The University of Parma, in cooperation with the partner institutions of the EU GREEN Alliance, hereby announces a call for applications for the selection of five (5) students to participate in a cultural and sporting event focused on inclusion. The event will take place at the **Centro Internacional de Innovación Deportiva en el Medio Natural “El Anillo” (Spain) from 19 to 23 October 2026**.

The call is addressed to students enrolled at the University of Parma who fall within one or more of the following categories:

- Students with an ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator) equal to or below €13,000 – 1 position
- Students with a certified disability of at least 66% and/or certification pursuant to Law 104/1992 – 1 position
- Students diagnosed with Specific Learning Disorders (SLD) – 1 position
- Non-EU students from particularly disadvantaged countries as defined by Ministerial Decree No. 176 of 24 February 2026 – 1 position
- Students holding refugee status – 1 position

The initiative is coordinated by the Universidad de Extremadura (Spain). For the current edition, the EU GREEN Alliance has designated the above-mentioned centre as the official venue.

The programme aims to foster inclusion and teamwork through a range of activities, including but not limited to:

- Paddle sports
- Water safety workshops
- Environmental protection laboratories
- Team-based aquatic competitions

In light of the planned activities, applicants are required to provide a self-declaration confirming their ability

to participate in aquatic and outdoor sports.

**In case of controversies, the Italian version of the Call for Applications prevails.**

## Participation requirements

---

In addition to belonging to one or more of the categories listed above, applicants must:

1. Be duly enrolled in a first- or second-cycle degree programme (Bachelor's, Master's, or Single-cycle degree) at the University of Parma for the academic year 2025/2026 at the time of application;
2. Be compliant with the payment of university tuition fees;
3. Not have incurred sanctions or revocations of benefits resulting from false self-declarations, including in previous academic years;
4. Demonstrate the ability to carry out water-based activities through self-certification.

Selected candidates must be regularly enrolled for the academic year 2026/2027 at the time of departure.

## Selection criteria

---

Applications will be evaluated by a Selection Committee appointed by Rector's Decree on the basis of the following criteria:

1. **Academic performance** (maximum 30 points), assessed according to the average grade:
  - a. 18–20 = 6 points
  - b. 21–23 = 12 points
  - c. 24–26 = 18 points
  - d. 27–29 = 24 points
  - e. 30 = 30 points
  - f. In the absence of recorded grades, 3 points will be assigned.
2. **Motivation statement (maximum 10 points):** applicants must submit a statement (maximum 800 characters, including spaces) outlining their motivation to participate, with particular reference to inclusion and solidarity.

In the event of a tie, the following criteria will be applied in order:

1. Gender balance
2. Younger age
3. Fewer previous international mobility experiences
4. Random selection

Separate ranking lists will be established for each category. Any unfilled positions will be redistributed proportionally among the remaining categories.

## Application procedure

---

Applications must be submitted between 29 April and 15 May 2026 via the ESSE3 platform by selecting:

- INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY OUTBOUND → EXCHANGE PROGRAMS → EU GREEN – AQUATIC AND OUTDOOR SPORTS EVENT EL ANILLO, SPAIN.

## Selection results

---

Ranking lists will be published on the official webpage. Selected candidates must confirm their participation within five (5) days since the publication of the rankings via the ESSE3 system.

## Financial support

---

The five-day programme is funded by the EU GREEN Alliance. Each selected student is awarded:

- Accommodation and subsistence costs:
  - €79 per day (short-term mobility grant) plus
  - additional €100 top-up.
- Travel costs:
  - €309 as fix and standard contribution, increased to €417 for green travel options (e.g. train, bus, carpooling, ship).

## Academic recognition

---

The University grants academic credits (CFU/ECTS) to students enrolled in its degree programmes who submit a formal request, for participation in extracurricular activities. Such activities may be of a sporting, cultural,

or social nature and must involve the active engagement of the student within the operational context in which the activities covered by this Call are carried out.

Participation in the event entails the award of 2 CFU/ECTS credits. The recognition of these credits is carried out by the International Mobility Committee (CMI) of the student's Department. For this purpose, students are required to submit a formal request prior to the commencement of the mobility period by completing the Learning Agreement.

## Personal data processing

Personal data provided by applicants to the University of Parma shall be processed, in either paper-based or electronic form, exclusively for purposes related to the conduct of the selection procedure and the management of any subsequent contractual relationship, in compliance with applicable legal provisions. The provision and collection of such data are mandatory for the proper administration of the selection process. Where special categories of personal data are concerned, pursuant to Article 9 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, processing shall be carried out for the purposes set out in Law No. 68/1999 and Law No. 104/1992. The provision of the data specified in this Call is compulsory and necessary for the assessment of eligibility requirements; failure to provide such data will result in exclusion from the selection procedure. Data collected within the framework of this administrative procedure may be communicated to other offices of the University of Parma and to external parties solely to the extent strictly necessary for the performance of their respective institutional functions, in accordance with current legal provisions. Applicants are granted the rights set out in Chapter III of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, including, in particular, the right to access their personal data, to request their rectification, updating, or erasure if incomplete, inaccurate, or unlawfully processed, as well as the right to object to their processing on legitimate grounds. Pursuant to Law No. 241 of 7 August 1990, as subsequently amended and supplemented by Law No. 15 of 11 February 2005, the Data Controller is Dr. Alessandro Bernazzoli, International Relations and EU GREEN Unit.
