Part B. Summary of CV

Scientific contributions

My CV details an intense, rigorous research activity with a strong international component. It is also heterogeneous in terms of research lines.

Principal Investigator of the Jean Monnet Module IECELS "The Influence of European Case-Law on the Evidence Law of National Legal Systems," reference 101239274, Call ERASMUS-JMO-2025-HEI-TCH-RSCH, duration 36 months (November 1, 2025, to October 31, 2028) and funding received €35,000.

Previously, I have coordinated a research project granted by the Centre for Legal Studies and Specialised Training (CEJFE) for the creation of courts specialising in violence against children.

I have been a member of the research team of 6 national or Next Generation funded R&D projects; 6 regional projects, and 1 European project funded by the European Commission and led by the University of Luxembourg. I am the Principal Researcher on a project of the University of Girona regarding Legal certainty and effectiveness of justice (critical points of procedural reforms from the perspective of comparative law). I would like to highlight that I belong to the Research Group at the University of Girona on "Current Issues in Procedural Law".

Regarding the quality, relevance and dissemination of research activity, I have to my name:

2 monographs as sole author with prestigious publishers such as Marcial Pons and Aranzadi, respectively.

7 directorships and/or coordinator roles in collective works.

I have published various articles in journals highly regarded in the reference indexes of the procedural discipline (levels A and B). I am the author of several contributions in collective books, both in civil and criminal procedural matters. In all, in excess of 50.

The directorship of a collection of Studies on Procedural Law and Evidence Law, Editorial Aranzadi, which directly fits in with the theme of the requested project.

Contributions to society

As a contribution to society, we must highlight a constant and equally intense teaching activity, both at undergraduate and postgraduate level. Not only at the University of Girona, but at other universities. In this sense, I have taught undergraduate and postgraduate courses at the UOC (Open University of Catalonia) (since 2012); postgraduate courses at the Abat Oliba-CEU University (since the 2020-21 academic year), and at the Pablo Olavide University of Seville

(since the 2023-24 academic year). In addition to the performance as a collaborating professor at the Public Security Institute of Catalonia (in the training of Police and Mossos d'Esquadra - Catalan Regional Police-) during 2019 and 2020.

In addition, I have been a visiting professor at the Italian Universities of Pisa and Genoa and at the University of Talca (Chile).

I have directed or coordinated two teaching innovation projects at the University of Girona, and I participate, as a researcher, in others at the University of Valencia, the University of Almería, the University of Santiago de Compostela, and in the Interuniversity Network for Research and Teaching of Procedural Law in English.

I direct (together with Gianluca Borgia) the International Network of Young Jurists in Evidence Law - PROBATICIUS (<https://www.probaticius.com/>) which, through its activities, reaches a wide audience made up of university professors and researchers; lawyers; other legal professionals; PhD students and university students.

Contributions to the training of young researchers

In line with the above, while directing the PROBATICIUS Network I have made a significant contribution to the training of young researchers and young lawyers. This Network has over 150 members from various countries and holds an annual congress (the third edition will be held in October 2025), in addition to other seminars or workshops, courses and active collaboration with the Barcelona Bar Association (ICAB) and other national and international institutions. All the results of this research are published (after a period of time in open access) in the collection called PROBATICIUS by the Aranzadi publishing house, of which I am the director. Likewise, within the framework of PROBATICIUS, working groups have been created for the analysis of procedural reforms and updated jurisprudence in matters of evidentiary law and in civil, criminal, labor and contentious-administrative procedural law. There is no doubt that the impact of the requested project is guaranteed with the collaboration of this Network.
